## Who Will Repair My Church Today?

The outlook on the future is by no means free from anxiety; on the contrary, there are many serious reasons for alarm, on account of numerous and long-standing causes of evil, of both a public and a private nature.

... Who could fail to be moved by the present evident increase of devotion towards the person of Our Saviour? The ardent zeal of so many thousands, united in heart and mind, "from the rising of the Sun to the going down thereof," in venerating the Name of Jesus Christ and proclaiming His praises, is worthy of the best days of Christianity. Would that the outburst of these flames of antique faith might be followed by a mighty conflagration! Would that the splendid example of so many might kindle the enthusiasm of all!


...The most important duty of the Church, and the one most peculiarly her own, is to defend and to propagate throughout the world the Kingdom of the Son of God, and to bring all men to salvation by communicating to them the divine benefits, so much so that her power and authority are chiefly exercised in this one work.

## (Pope Leo XIII, Tametsi Futura Prospicientibus, On Jesus Christ the Redeemer.)

Pope Leo XIII wrote this encyclical in 1900, the dawn of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, a century that would be marked by great evil, moral decay, attacks on marriage and the family, the rise of atheism and Nazism and blatant opposition to God. Pope Leo was inspired by the devotion of the people of his time but feared for their future, as he sensed the world beginning a spiral into the abyss of self-destruction--life without God, life held hostage by mere human science and the corrupted human will. For years we have been experiencing the anxiety Pope Leo referenced as we confront the sins of omission and commission in our spiritual leadership. The result has been a crisis of faith, widespread apostacy, compromise of Church teaching, and total disregard for God's Will for mankind's salvation outlined in His immutable laws, the Natural Law written in our very nature, and the Moral Law, carved in stone in evidence of its immutability. God speaks from His Eternal Now; His laws are the same yesterday, today and tomorrow. They do not change, for that would be imperfection, and God is perfect. His laws are relevant for

every age. God's laws contain the enduring prescription for harmony in every human relationship, that with God, with one's neighbor and with oneself. It is a prescription for peace in one's life and the salvation of one's soul. No one, not even the Pope, can change the laws of God.

This week the whole world finally received the McCarrick



Report which confirms that the smoke of satan has entered into the highest places within our Church. It gives evidence that there is a deep state within our Church as well as within our government, and the two work together. It was against these "long-standing causes of evil, of both a public and a private nature" that Our Blessed Mother appeared

at various times in the 20<sup>th</sup> century. At Fatima in 1917, she called for repentance, especially against the sins of impurity, and for praying the rosary for peace and an end to

World War I. But she warned of a worse war and a third world war if people did not change their lives. God is already too much offended. Our Lady gave the shepherd children a vision of hell and said more souls go to hell for sins against purity than any other sin. She called for the consecration of Russia to her Immaculate Heart to stop the spread of atheism. On September 26, 1956, Our Lady appeared to Sister Mildred Mary Neuzil in America to focus on purity.

"I am Our Lady of America. I desire that my children honor me, especially by the purity of their lives." ... "My child, I entrust you with this message that you must make known to my children in America. I wish it to be the country dedicated to my purity. ... I desire, through my children in America, to further the cause of faith and purity among peoples and nations." ... "Those who are found in the circle of my rosary will never be lost." Sr. Mildred Neuzil, Diary, OUR LADY OF AMERICA, Tiffin, OH, Pgs. 10-11.)

Our Blessed Lady again called for repentance and reparation for sin and for a reform of life, sanctification from within through union with the Indwelling Most Holy Trinity, which is living in the state of grace. She again warned of great chastisement if we did not repent



of our sins. She especially mandated the bishops of the United States to carry out her requests for the enthronement of her statue in her shrine, the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C., honoring her there as Our Lady of America, the Immaculate Virgin, for the protection of our land, for she warned that the evil that is enveloping the world is focused on America. She stated:

"Unless my children reform their lives, they will suffer great persecution. If man himself will not take upon himself the penance necessary to atone for his sins and those of others, God in His justice will have to send upon him the punishment necessary to atone for his transgressions." ... "It is the darkest hour. But if men will come to me, my Immaculate





Heart will make it bright again with the mercy which my Son will rain down through my hands. Help me save those who will not save themselves. Help me bring once again the sunshine of God's peace upon the world." (The Diary, Pg. 15.)

On June 12, 1973, Our Lady appeared to Sister Agnes Sasagawa asking for prayers for the Pope, bishops and priests, warning that the devil had infiltrated the Church and cardinals would oppose cardinals and bishops oppose bishops. Good priests would be scorned. Again, she warned that if mankind did not repent of its sins, there would be a chastisement worse than the deluge; fire would fall from the sky and a great part of humanity would be destroyed. Our Lady asked that we offer the sufferings of Our Lord to soften the Father's anger. With each appearance Our Lady offers us her assistance, especially by way of the rosary, in preventing terrible judgements upon the world. "Pray very much the prayers of the Rosary. I alone am able to save you from the calamities which approach. Those who place their confidence in me will be saved." (www.ewtn.com/catholicism/library/message-from-our-lady--akita-japan)

In Garabandal, Spain, Our Lady appeared in 1961-1965 to four school girls, again calling for penance, for the cup is filling up. **"Pray and make others pray, because the world is on the road to perdition.** In 1981-1989 Our Lady appeared to three young school girls in Kibeho, Rwanda, where the rosary was abandoned, statues were desecrated and she



was not honored. Our Lady again asked for prayer and repentance to prevent a terrible war, but in 1994, a genocide took place between the Hutu and Tutsi tribes, killing 800,000 people or more. It was described as a "river of blood." Our Lady appeared there as Our Lady of the Word and as Mother of God. She asked for a shrine to be built where she appeared and presented herself, quite fittingly, as Our Lady of Sorrows. She asked for the rosary of the seven sorrows to be prayed for

continued conversion, reparation and reconciliation.


Our Lady appears when there is great heresy and great sin in the world. She comes to warn us and call us to repentance to avoid God's judgement. She comes as our Mother of Mercy to lead us to her Divine Son Who is Mercy Itself.

The greatest of all misfortunes is never to have known Jesus Christ: yet such a state is free from the sin of obstinacy and ingratitude. But first to have known Him, and afterwards to deny or forget Him, is a crime so foul and so insane that it seems impossible for any man to be guilty of it. For Christ is the fountain-head of all good. Mankind can no more be saved without His power, than it could be redeemed without His mercy. "Neither is there salvation in any other. For there is no other name under heaven given to men whereby we must be saved." (Acts iv, 12). (Tametsi Futura, #3.)

On July 13, 1981, Our Lord spoke to Sister Mildred Neuzil in these words: ... many false doctrines are being taught and for many the true Christ is never made known. The false prophets and self-proclaimed Messiahs are drawing many away from Me the Way, the Truth and the Life. I am the true Messiah who was sent and the only one proclaimed as such

by My Father. Seek Me for I only am truth, I only am the Christ." (The Diary, Pg. 40.)

O Immaculate Mother, Queen of our Country, open our hearts, our homes, and our Land to the coming of Jesus, your Divine Son. With Him, reign over us, O heavenly Lady, so pure and so bright with the radiance of God's light shining in and about you. Be our Leader against the powers of evil set upon wresting the world of souls, redeemed at such a great cost by the sufferings of your Son and of



yourself, in union with Him, from that same Savior, Who loves us with infinite charity. ... By thy Holy and Immaculate Conception, O Mary, deliver us from evil. Amen.

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
