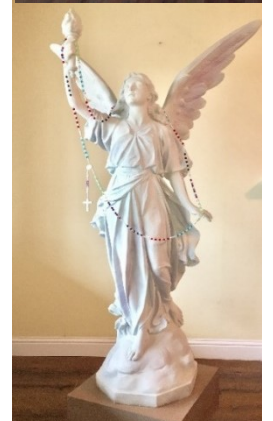
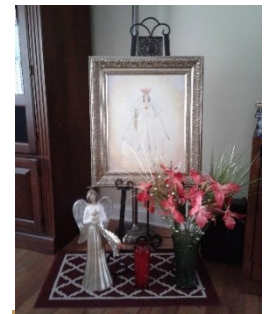

St. Michael came to Sister shortly after this visit from Our Lady regarding the challenge to the youth of America; he presented her with an immense flaming torch. **“My little sister, you must carry this torch through the world.”** She was enlightened at Mass the next day that those, particularly the youth, willing to follow Our Lady in her great battle against evil would bear the special title of **“Torchbearers of the Queen.”** The torch is Divine Love which alone can conquer hate and the evil that hate brings.

This Youth Emblem was the result of four years of reflection on this mission for the youth of America. The emblem symbolizes the ideal of “Youth Alive in Christ and Christ Alive in Youth.” It is a badge of unity for Christian youth worldwide, a unity that flows from a common baptism into the life of Jesus Christ and which will build up the Mystical Body of Christ, which is the people of God, the Church. The Gospel proclaims Christ is the

Way, the Truth, and the Life. Youth alive in Christ will witness to the truth of the Gospel of Life by striving for holiness through imitation of Christ.

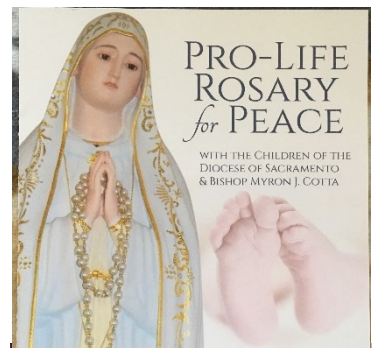
The center of the emblem is formed with the letters Y.O.U.T.H. The letters form the symbol of the Eucharist, the host as the Body of Christ and the chalice filled with His Precious Blood. Youth are thus reminded that the Body of Christ is the sacrament of His Love, the sacrament that gives grace and life to the soul, which is necessary for virtuous living. This life-giving Body of Christ radiates outward as symbolized by red and gold rays to light up the world. The Holy Spirit presides above in the symbol of a dove of peace to enlighten youth in the ways of creating peace and reverence for life. The Holy Spirit seals the youth with the Gift of Fortitude which is the gift of courage to do what is right under difficult circumstances. Spirit-filled youth will promote the Culture of Life and Love in the Third Millennium.



A vibrant group of youth formed the Sacramento area Torchbearers of the Queen in a serious commitment to Our Lady's mandate to them to lead the world in a spiritual renewal never before so necessary and so vital. They carried this beautiful life-size statue of Our Lady of America in World Youth Day 1993 in Denver, Colorado, and were joined by youth from other nations carrying it close to the platform where St. John Paul II could approach and bless it. It has been carried in other World Youth Days since. They are alive in Christ and Christ is surely alive in them!

January 22, 2021 marks the 48th anniversary of the Roe vs. Wade decision of the Supreme Court legalizing abortion. If this bad law is ever to be over-turned with a correct law in line with the constitutional guarantee of the right to life, an intrinsic right given by God and not open to interpretation by human courts, it will be up to our youth to effect that change and to save millions of the most vulnerable and innocent of human beings among us. Abortion is a human rights violation at the very core of the meaning of life itself. We have a Pro-Life generation of youth, and we pray that it will swell with each coming generation to undo the evil that their elders have committed against a whole class of human persons, pre-born children. This legalized genocide ought to cause outrage in any *truly human* heart. Young people of America, and the world, pick up the Torch and carry it! This is your time! This is your mission! Do not disappoint heaven!

Adults willing to follow Jesus and Our Lady in this enormous battle against evil, you, too, must carry the Torch! We are all youth in the Spirit, forever young. Sister Mildred's Diary carries a very strong message meant for adult Torchbearers, spoken by Jesus Himself on July 13, 1981, during the month in which we honor His Most Precious Blood.



“My faithful spouse, the world does not know me. My people do not know me. I am a stranger to them. Many claim to love me yet hate and kill their neighbor and say they do it in My Name. These listen to the false prophets who are manipulated by the powers of evil. Me they do not follow. Me they do not hear. With the same tongue with which these benighted souls praise and proclaim their love and dedication to Me they curse and condemn their neighbor whom I redeemed as I did them.



Many unnatural acts are being committed in the name of love. This evil is being disguised and tolerated as an intrinsic right like any other. Even some of My priests and consecrated virgins are being caught up into this web of evil, not realizing its terrible consequences. [our emphasis]



My dearest one, many false doctrines are being taught and for many the true Christ is never made known. The false prophets and self-proclaimed Messiahs are drawing many away from Me, the Way, the Truth and the Life. I am the true Messiah who was sent and the only one proclaimed as such by My Father. Seek Me for I only am truth. I only am the Christ.” (The Diary, Pg. 40.)

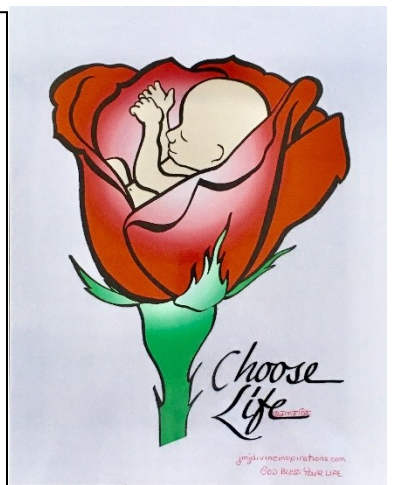
