

A Prayer Campaign for America

October 7, Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, Until Time Is No More

“I am the Archangel..., Protector, Guardian and Defender of America whose soil is saturated with martyrs’ blood and honors so highly the Queen of Heaven and Her holy Spouse who work only to further the Kingdom of Jesus.

With these shafts of light God seeks out and binds with eternal chains the evil powers and those who have sold themselves to these enemies of God and His people. They who are chained to habits of sin through weakness but have hearts filled with guilt and repentance will have their chains broken so that they will be free once more to love and serve their Maker.

Listen to the words and warnings of the Queen of Heaven and you will experience my protection and I will fight in your defense that with the people of all Nations you can at last come to the peace of the Kingdom which is within you.”

Sixty years ago, on September 26, 1956, Our Lady appeared and identified herself to Sister Mildred Mary Neuzil saying: **“I am Our Lady of America.”** She entrusted Sister with a message for the United States of America in particular. Sister stated that **“this title was the sign of Our Lady’s pleasure at the confidence our land places in her and as a reward for its staunch and childlike devotion to her.”** We recall that on February 7, 1847 Pope Pius IX approved the title of the Immaculate Conception as Patroness of our beloved Land. On December 8, 1854 he defined the dogma of the Immaculate Conception. On the feast of the Annunciation, March 25, 1858 Our Lady identified herself to Bernadette at Lourdes as **“I am the Immaculate Conception.”** The fact that Our Lady appeared to Sister Mildred Neuzil first as Our Lady of Lourdes confirms the deep connection of all these events to the apparition of Our Lady of America®, an apparition of **great favor** to America preceding the **Mandate from heaven** Our Lady has given to America. Our Lady wishes to use America to help bring faith and purity and peace, Christ’s peace, back to the world. Purity! Faith! And Peace!

“I wish it to be the country dedicated to my purity. The wonders I will work will be the wonders of the soul. They must have faith and believe firmly in my love for them. I desire that they be the children of my Pure Heart. I desire, through my children in America, to further the cause of faith and purity among peoples and nations.” ... [Though she came in this manner as a token of her love for us, nevertheless Our Lady of America® welcomes her children of all nations to her feet, for there will be found true peace.] ... “I do not promise miracles of the body, but of the soul.” ... “Pray and do penance, my sweet child, that this may come to pass.” (Diary, Pgs. 10-15.)

A few days later, October 5, 1956, Sister Mildred felt compelled to write a prayer to Our Lady, Patroness of our land. The thoughts flowed into her mind until the prayer was finished.

Prayer to the Immaculate Conception

O Immaculate Mother, Queen of our Country, open our hearts, our homes, and our Land to the coming of Jesus, your Divine Son. With Him, reign over us, O heavenly Lady, so pure and so bright with the radiance of God's light shining in and about you. Be our Leader against the powers of evil set upon wresting the world of souls, redeemed at such a great cost by the sufferings of your Son and of yourself, in union with Him, from that same Savior, Who loves us with infinite charity.

We gather about you, O chaste and holy Mother, Virgin Immaculate, Patroness of our beloved Land, determined to fight under your banner of holy purity against the wickedness that would make all the world an abyss of evil, without God and without your loving maternal care.

We consecrate our hearts, our homes, our Land to your Most Pure Heart, O great Queen, that the kingdom of your Son, our Redeemer and our God, may be firmly established in us. We ask no special sign of you, sweet Mother, for we believe in your great love for us, and we place in you our entire confidence. We promise to honor you by faith, love, and the purity of our lives according to your desire.

Reign over us, then, O Virgin Immaculate, with your Son Jesus Christ. May His Divine Heart and your most chaste Heart be ever enthroned and glorified among us. Use us, your children of America, as your instruments in bringing peace among men and nations. Work your miracles of grace in us, so that we may be a glory to the Blessed Trinity, Who created, redeemed, and sanctifies us.

May your valiant Spouse, St. Joseph, with the holy Angels and Saints, assist you and us in "renewing the face of the earth." Then when our work is over, come, Holy Immaculate Mother, and as our Victorious Queen, lead us to the eternal kingdom, where your Son reigns forever as King. Amen.

The following year on the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, October 7, 1957, Our Lady appeared holding a rosary in her clasped hands and warned, if we, her children in America, do not reform our lives God, in His justice and mercy, would have to cleanse us in the fires of untold punishments, punishments hitherto unknown to us. We must be purified in order to receive His peace, so long promised and so long held back because of our sins. We are reminded of Our Lady's message at Fatima just 40 years earlier in 1917 when she asked the three shepherd children to pray many rosaries for the conversion of sinners and the salvation of souls, for an end to the war and for peace. She especially asked that Russia, fount of so much evil in the 20th Century and from which the errors of atheism would spread throughout the world, be made sacred by consecration to her Immaculate Heart. Our Lady pleaded: **"Do not offend the Lord our God anymore, because He is already so much offended."** Our Lady is asking us, too, to pray the rosary every day, especially as a family, in atonement for our own sins and to help her save those who will not save themselves, and for a return to faith and purity so that the sunshine of Christ's peace might return to our world.

"Making the rosary a family prayer is very pleasing to me. I ask that all families strive to do so. But be careful to say it with great devotion, meditating on each mystery and striving to imitate in your daily lives the virtues depicted therein. Live the mysteries of the rosary as I lived them, and it will become a chain binding you to me forever. They who are found in the circle of my rosary will never be lost. I myself will lead them at death to the throne of my Son, to be eternally united to Him." ... "Oh, if you knew the punishments I am holding back from you by my pleading and intercession on your behalf." (Diary, Pg. 21.)

St. Dominic, a gifted preacher, complained to Our Lady that his sermons were ineffectual. She gave him the rosary as a weapon against heresy and vice. The results were astounding. When he died, however, devotion to the rosary waned. A terrible pestilence broke out and the people begged a hermit to plead with Our Lady for relief. Our Lady then appeared and said:

"These people have stopped singing my praises. This is why they have been visited with such a scourge. If they will only go back to the ancient devotion of the Most Holy Rosary, they will enjoy my protection. I shall see to their salvation if only they will sing the Rosary, for I love this type of chanting." So the people did what Mary asked and made themselves rosaries, which they started saying with all their heart and soul. (Louis De Montfort, THE SECRET OF THE ROSARY, Pg. 123

When will we do what Our Lady of America® is asking of us? Are we seeking sanctification from within through union with the Divine Indwelling of the Most Holy Trinity? Do we practice the simple virtues lived by the Holy Family at Nazareth? Our Lady warns of evil parading as good and how good people fall into ruin for lack of discerning false spirits from true ones. Jesus Himself appeared to Sister Mildred warning against false doctrines, false prophets and messiahs, and those who call **"unnatural acts"** done in the name of love intrinsic rights like any other. (Diary, Pg. 40, July 13, 1981.) **Unnatural acts! Done in the name of love?**

"My child, I come again for men have not changed their lives. Their sins cry to heaven for punishment. I hold out help, they will not receive it. I show them the way to peace but they only spurn the efforts of my love. It is late, sweet child, oh how late. (Diary, Pg. 36, June 26, 1967.)

[February 11, 1981, Sister Mildred noted: There is an urgency about Our Lady and when she speaks which leaves no doubts as to the closeness of the terrible purification that is about to fall upon all nations. Every one of us knows, in a personal way, the sacrifices expected of us. This is a responsibility to be decided upon by each individual and carried out in that manner with love and trust in God's mercy. God never fails those who put all their love and trust in Him. We have nothing to fear then if we do our part. But we must begin now because time is running out. (Diary, Pg. 39.)

Sister stated that Our Lady wants us to pray the **family rosary** and the **Prayer TO THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, PATRONESS OF [the] UNITED STATES** each day, for the Forces of Evil are enveloping the world and their hatred is **"particularly focused on the United States because of the Divine Mandate given to it to lead the world to peace."** (Diary, Pg. 39.)

In 1966 Pope Paul VI wrote his encyclical "Christi Matri" urging people to turn to Mary in times of trouble. As misfortune increases, so should our devotion to Mary, especially devotion to the rosary. Thus, the month of October was dedicated to this devotion. The home is the basic unit of society and is the domestic image of the larger church; as in the Church, it also needs some form of common prayer to bind it together in love and ministry. The rosary is Our Lady's choice for the common prayer of the family. As Father Peyton said, "**The family that prays together stays together.**"

Today our news is filled with talk of nuclear proliferation and threats of nuclear war. **When asked on January 3, 1984 if there would be a nuclear war**, Our Lady responded:

"My faithful one, if my warnings are taken seriously and enough of my children strive constantly and faithfully to renew and reform themselves in their inward and outward lives, then there will be no nuclear war. What happens to the world depends upon those who live in it. There must be much more good than evil prevailing in order to prevent the holocaust that is so near approaching.

...even should such a destruction happen because there were not enough souls who took my warning seriously, there will remain a remnant—untouched by the chaos who, having been faithful in following and spreading my warnings, will gradually inhabit the earth again with their dedicated and holy lives." (Diary, Pg. 45.)

Our greatest prayer is always the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass which offers back to God His own Perfect Sacrifice for the atonement of our sins and which acknowledges God as Our Father. Jesus mediates. Mary intercedes with a Mother's heart. She has a unique relationship with each person of the Trinity, as revealed in the devotion of the Three Hail Mary's given to St. Melchtilde in the 13th century. The first honors the Father Whose Omnipotence raised Mary to a position of **power** higher than any other creature. The second honors the Son Who communicated His inscrutable **Wisdom** to His Mother. The third honors the Holy Spirit Who filled her with God's **grace** and **mercy**. The Three Hail Mary's also honor the three great privileges bestowed upon Mary: the **Immaculate Conception** ordained by the Father, her **Divine Motherhood** of the Son, and her **Perpetual Virginity** preserved by the Holy Spirit.

Beginning October 7th, feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, let us commit to doing our part to save America and the world from ruin and to bring it Christ's peace through the recognition of God in every soul. Let us storm heaven to prevent a nuclear war and to turn America back to its Judeo-Christian roots and its respect for the Supreme Authority of God over our Land and every nation and person on earth. Let us undo invalid human laws that oppose the Divine Law. Let us circumcise our own hearts so we may be fit to lead others. The age old battle is still the same: it is between Satan and The Christ, Satan's cohorts and Christ's disciples.

Our Lady of America® gave us her **peace plan**. First, restore our **reverence for the Eucharist** and participate in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass every day, if possible. At Mass gather the suffering of the world and offer the blood of the millions of innocents massacred in the womb or in genocides around the world with the Blood of the Lamb of God for the redemption of those who commit, legalize or profit from these evils against the human person. Secondly, let us pray with our families the **daily rosary** and the **Prayer to the Immaculate**

Conception, Patroness of our Land. We might add the Three Hail Mary's to acknowledge the special intercession we have in Mary, our Patroness. Thirdly, let us say daily, too, the beautiful **Prayer to the Indwelling Most Holy Trinity** that Sister Mildred gave us so we might be sanctified from within and transformed into the image of the Son so pleasing to the Father.

Prayer to the Indwelling Most Holy Trinity

O my Love, my only Good, Most Holy Trinity, I adore You, hidden in the depths of my soul. To You, to Your honor and glory, I dedicate my life. May every thought, word and deed of mine be an act of adoration and praise directed towards your Divine Majesty enthroned in my heart.

O Father, Infinite Goodness, behold Your child, clothed in the likeness of Your Son. Extend to me Your arms that I may belong to You forever.

O Son, Divine Lord, made man, crucify me with Yourself that I may become, in union with You, a sacrifice of praise for the glory of Your Father.

O Holy Spirit, Fire of Everlasting Love, consume me on the altar of Divine Charity, that at the end of life, nothing may remain but that which bears the likeness of Christ.

O Blessed Trinity, worthy of all adoration, I wish to remain in spirit on my knees, to acknowledge forever Your reign in me and over me, to Your everlasting glory. Through the Immaculate Heart of Mary and the pure heart of St. Joseph, I consecrate my life to Your adoration and glory.

At the moment of death, receive me, O my Triune Love, that I may continue my adoration of love through all eternity. Amen. (200 days)
